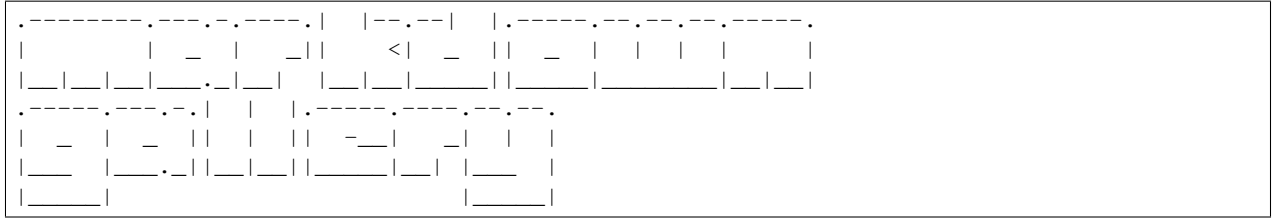

1.1.1 About

markdown gallery watches a directory for new images, generates thumbnails and outputs a markdown file with your images.

1.1.2 Usage

You might want to change:

- in **gallery_to_markdown.py** `ABSOLUTE_URL`: Absolute url of your site. *http://mysite.com/gallery*.
- in **gallery.py** `THUMBNAIL_PREFIX`: Prefix for thumbnail. Defaults to *t_* `THUMBNAILS_DIR`: Name of thumbnail directory inside a gallery, default *t*. `THUMBNAIL_SIZE`: Defaults to *128x128*.
- in **gallery_watcher.py** `THUMBNAIL_PREFIX`, `THUMBNAILS_DIR`, `THUMBNAIL_SIZE`, `OUTPUT_FILE`: These constants are ignored by `gallery_watcher`. This is redundant but keep it same as in `gallery.py`. `WATCH_DIRECTORY`: root directory of your galleries. That would be */home/galleries* in below file tree.
