#### 1.1.1 About

markdown gallery watches a directory for new images, generates thumbnails and outputs a markdown file with your images.

#### 1.1.2 **Usage**

You might want to change:

- in gallery\_to\_markdown.py ABSOLUTE\_URL: Absolute url of your site. http://mysite.com/gallery.
- in gallery.py THUMBNAIL\_PREFIX: Prefix for thumbnail. Defaults to t\_ THUMBNAILS\_DIR: Name of thumbnail directory inside a gallery, default t. THUMBNAIL\_SIZE: Defaults to 128x128.
- in gallery\_watcher.py THUMBNAIL\_PREFIX, THUMBNAILS\_DIR, THUMBNAIL\_SIZE, OUT-PUT\_FILE: These constants are ignored by gallery\_watcher. This is redundant but keep it same as in gallery.py. WATCH\_DIRECTORY: root directory of your galleries. That would be /home/galleries in below file tree.
